WHO WE ARE

Izzy's Promise is a charity organisation (Charity No. SC033706) based in Dundee, Scotland (UK) that offers free and confidential support services to: Ritual/organised abuse survivors; Refugees; Asylum seekers; Ethnic minorities' and Persons trafficked via rituals. Izzy's Promise offers training and consultancy services; Conducts research into causes of ritual abuse and any ways of preventing or relieving the suffering caused by abuse; recruits and trains volunteers to work towards supporting survivors of ritual/organised abuse and those who support them; and networks with other agencies. The outcome of all these services we offer is to enhance the survivors' confidence. We offer support services for male and female survivors of ritual abuse across the UK by consulting with them to find out what suits them best and how they can best be supported. We offer practical and emotional support for people trying to move out of abusive situations through workshops and therapy sessions aimed at empowering them to lead an independent life. We have developed adaptable training resource packs (training pack, DVD's and books) for training purposes. We support abuse survivors who have been trafficked by use of rituals such as voodoo and ju-ju mostly from Africa and the Caribbean. We provide training and consultancy services to agencies dealing with asylum seekers and refugees who have suffered from ritual abuse.

As the only specialist organisation in the UK offering support to survivors of ritual/organised abuse, the demand of our support services has increased over the years. WHAT WE DO:

We offer ritual abuse training at three levels: Basic RA, Intermediate RA and Advanced RA Training.

- Basic Ritual Abuse Training: what it is, a definition of ritual abuse, how it
 affects people, basic support skills
- Intermediate Ritual Abuse Training: working with survivors who are still involved, different kinds of RA, long term support
- Advanced Ritual Abuse Training: working with complex needs, mental health problems, multiple personalities etc
- Training for support workers: Working with issues around trafficking by use of rituals such as juju and voodoo

THE TRAINING:

Ritual abuse support workers' needs may be diverse but meeting them should be straight forward. We offer a broad range of training on different topics on ritual abuse which can be run in-house allowing your staff to attend together and share the learning at a time and place that suits you.

During that time she has increasingly provided training and talks to many agencies on the subject of ritual and organised abuse.

In 2002, due to an extremely high, and fast growing demand for services for people who had experienced organised and ritual abuse, she set up an





organisation called Tayside Ritual Abuse Support and Information Project (TRASH). This organisation has rapidly developed services for ritual abuse survivors and is now the lead agency in the UK. This organisation has recently been renamed Izzy's Promise.

Through Izzy's Promise she has worked with many hundreds of survivors of organised and ritual abuse and carried out several consultations, surveys and research into the subject. She regularly acts as a consultant for other organisations including the police, social services and the voluntary sector. She has spoken at conferences in the UK and the USA, and she is in high demand to provide training, talks and awareness on organised and ritual abuse for a wide range of agencies.

She is a published author on the subject of ritual abuse. Her published books about ritual abuse include; 'Who Dares Wins' 2001, 'Where Angels Fear: Ritual Abuse In Scotland', 2002, 'Fight! Rabbit! Fight!' 2003, 'BeAware: How to Support Young Survivors of Sexual Abuse', 2001 and 'Behind Enemy Lines' 2004.
